

REGULATION OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS
of 15 December 2008
on Starachowice special economic zone

On the basis of art. 4 indent 1 of the act of 20 October 1994 on special economic zones (Journal of laws, Polish ref. numbers: Dz. U. From 2007 No. 42, item 274 and from 2007 No. 118, item 746) it is ordered as follows:

- § 1. 1. "Starachowice" Special Economic Zone established by a regulation of the Council of Ministers of 09 September 1997 on establishment of "Starachowice" Special Economic Zone (the Journal of Laws, Dz. U. No. 135, item 906, as amended), called hereinafter "the zone", covers the area determined by the boundaries whose description is comprised in the annex hereto.
2. The zone covers land with area 644.4646 ha, situated on the area of towns: Kielce, Ostrowiec Świętokrzyski, Puławy, Skarżysko-Kamienna, Starachowice and of municipalities: Iłża, Końskie, Mniszków, Morawica, Piekoszów, Połaniec, Sędziszów, Stąporków, Suchedniów, Szydłowiec and Tułowice.
3. The zone is active till 31 December 2026.
4. The zone is administered by Specjalna Strefa Ekonomiczna „Starachowice” SA [joined stock company] with headquarters in Starachowice.
- § 2. Income of zone manager is released from corporate income tax in the part spent in the tax year or in the year following it for zone development purposes, including purchase by the manager of real estate or other objects serving for running business on the area of the zone and modernisation and development of economic and technical infrastructure on the premises of the zone.
- § 3. The regulation shall come from 30 December 2008.
